Subansiri-Koduk Meeting Point



Koduk, a serene tributary of the majestic Subansiri River, is a hidden gem nestled among the Eastern Himalayan mountain ranges. The confluence of these two rivers creates a mesmerizing spectacle, surrounded by verdant greenery and pristine landscapes. This enchanting meeting point is a haven for nature lovers, offering an idyllic retreat into the lap of

untouched wilderness. The unparalleled scenic beauty of the area is best experienced from up close where one can see water flowing gently through lush foliage, painting a perfect picture of tranquility and harmony. Nacho Town View Point

Nacho Town View Point locally known as Rarba is located 2 Km From Main Town Towards International Border. From here, the mesmerising landscape of Nacho can be seen along with the beautiful River Subansiri flowing in between two mountain ranges. This is a perfect spot to capture Nacho's Landscape in the form of a picture postcard.

Si Donyi (4th - 6th January)

The Si-Donyi, festival of the Tagin community, will be celebrated in January 2025. Observed every year from January 4-6, the festival is a vibrant showcase of the Tagin culture and traditions. In Nacho, preparations are underway to mark the occasion, with festivities commencing on January 4.

Visitors can look forward to experiencing traditional practices such as priestly chants, the sacrificial ceremony of the Mithun, and a display of local attire and cuisine. The event will also feature food stalls, offering a chance to savour authentic Tagin delicacies. This celebration promises a unique cultural experience, highlighting the rich heritage of the Tagin people.
